Applications and Scholarship Check List are due to the Counseling Center by March 19, 2014.

- **Buick Achievers Scholarship Program** The program details and scholarship application is available online at www.buickachievers.com. High school seniors who plan to enroll in a four-year college and major in a field of study that focuses on engineering, technology, design or business, with an interest in the automotive industry are encouraged to apply. The deadline to apply in February 28, 2014 at 5:00PM.
- **Gertrude McDaris & Sidney H. Ruskin Scholarship** Applicants must be of the Baptist, Methodist, or Presbyterian faith and must be of the Cherokee Indian descent or Anglo-Saxon descent. They must have ancestors who resided in one of the original 13 colonies at the time of the Revolutionary War. Applicants must also have a minimum GPA of a 2.5. Applications are available online at www.csascholars.org and must be submitted by March 3, 2014. More information is available in the Counseling Center.
- **Catch the Spirit of Appalachian Scholarships** There are four different scholarships for students in Jackson, Swain, Haywood and Macon Counties interested in Appalachian Studies (Traditional Crafts, Traditional Music, Community Service, and Visual Arts/Writing/History. - Scotty Cochran Scholarship Students whose family is a member of Haywood County Farm Bureau will have priority but others are encouraged to apply! Students must be a resident of Haywood County and plan on attending a technical/community, junior college, or four-year institution. Students must have a 2.5 GPA, provide evidence of financial need, and have significant community service. Scholarship applications are available in the Counseling Center and applications must be returned to Haywood County Farm Bureau by March 15, 2014.
