Preparing For College: How Do We Begin?

- Register for the October SAT if needed by September 10.
- Some colleges may require you to take SAT Subject Tests. Those are given in October or November.
- Narrow your list of colleges to 5 and make sure you are aware of application deadlines.
- If you have received a fee waiver for SAT, fee waivers are available for college application fees. Please see me.
- Attend College Night at HCC and <u>come prepared</u> to talk with college representatives about specific questions regarding housing, scholarships, school activities, academic programs, etc.
- Prepare Early Decision, Early Action, or rolling admissions applications as soon as possible.
- Think about who you will ask to complete recommendation letters and give them as least a one-week notice.
- Look at colleges of interest and their websites for information about possible scholarships requiring a separate application other than the admission application.
