NOVEMBER SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION



(Please check with colleges regarding scholarships to ensure deadlines are met! This is not a complete list but scholarships that we are aware of at this time.)

- **NAVY ROTC Scholarships**—Please let your counselor know if you are interested in a Navy ROTC Scholarship so that we can set up a meeting with our local recruiter. The typical SAT score needed is 1150 for combined Critical Reading and Math or a ACT composite score of 24.
- **\$** Air Force ROTC Scholarships—Please let your counselor know if you are interested so that we can set up a meeting with our local recruiter. The criteria includes SAT score of 1180 (Math & Critical reading only), ACT Composite of 26, and a GPA of 3.0.
- **\$ Berea College Scholarships**—Berea awards a 4-year, tuition scholarship to every admitted student. This scholarship works in conjunction with any other grants or scholarships students receive to completely cover the cost of tuition. If you are interested in attending Berea College—please see your counselor!!!
- Thomas Wolfe Scholarship at UNC Chapel Hill -The Thomas Wolfe Scholarship will accept applications for its 14th national search beginning September 1st, 2014. Please note that our application process involves two separate steps and two different dates, and all applicants must take both steps and meet both deadlines, to be eligible: 1/ Thomas Wolfe Scholarship applicants must apply to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill by the University's October 15th, 2015. EARLY admission deadline and must meet all academic requirements for EARLY admission; and 2/ Scholarship applicants must also apply to The Thomas Wolfe Scholarship, with the deadline for submissions to the Scholarship being November 15th, 2015 (submissions must be postmarked by that date). - **The University of Tennessee Knoxville**—December 1: Regular Deadline for Admission and Institutional Scholarships (including the Volunteer Scholarship program) More information is available at http://onestop.utk.edu/your-money/covering-costs/scholarships/
- **Appalachian State University Scholarships**—Once you have completed your admissions application by **November 15** (completed application includes high school transcript, completed CFNC application, and test scores), your admissions application will be evaluated for scholarship eligibility. Eligible students will receive an email with instructions for applying for merit scholarships at Appalachian.
- **\$ Robertson Scholars Leadership Program**—The Scholarship Program provides scholarships to students attending Duke University & The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. The online application is available at www.robertsonscholars.org and the deadline to apply is **November 15**. Once registered, you can use your username and password to access your application at any time. Please remember, your application to the Robertson Scholars Leadership Program is supplemental to your application to Duke University or the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. You must also apply for admission to Duke and/or UNC-Chapel Hill by the respective Regular Decision deadline(s).
- **\$** Clemson University Lyceum Scholars Program—Lyceum Scholars study the moral, political, and economics foundations of a free society. A unique curriculum and faculty mentor set this scholarship apart! Students need to apply at www.clemson.edu/capitalism/lyceum.html by **December 8**.
- **Roanoke College Scholars Program**—To apply, students must visit www.roanoke.edu/scholars by **November 13th** for the December Competition.
- **\$ Ronald McDonald House Charities Scholarship Program—**There are four different scholarships to apply for so please review information to see which scholarships you may be eligible for at https://aim.applyists.net/RMHC. We have had a Tuscola student win in the past so please apply! The application deadline is **January 20, 2016**.

- **Mensa Education and Research Foundation Scholarships**—The <u>only eligibility requirements</u> are that the applicant be enrolled, for the academic year following the award, in a degree program in an accredited American institute of post-secondary education, and be a resident of the area of a participating local group of American Mensa. For the general awards, the applicant need <u>not</u> be a member of Mensa nor qualified for Mensa, and the general awards are unrestricted as to age, race, gender, level of post-secondary education and financial need.
