

## FEBRUARY SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Please check with each college you are interested in regarding scholarships to ensure deadlines are met! This is not a complete list but scholarships that we are aware of at this time.

- \$ Haywood County Schools Foundation Scholarships—Applications are now available online at http://www.hcsf.haywood.k12.nc.us/ and typed applications are preferred. Students must apply for scholarships that they are eligible for so please check necessary requirements. Students must submit completed applications to the Counseling Center by March 13, 2017.
- **\$** The Matthew C. Graziadei Achievement Award—Application Deadline is February 15, 2017. A scholarship of \$1000 will be awarded to a NC high school senior with a disability. See your counselor if you are interested in being nominated. For more information visit www.ecac-parentcenter.org.
- **\$** Gertrude McDaris & Sidney H. Ruskin Scholarship Fund— Applications available at www.csascholars.org. The deadline for this scholarship is February 06, 2017. Must be of the Cherokee Indian descent; or Anglo-Saxon decent and have ancestors who resided in one of the original 13 colonies at the time of the Revolutionary War.

- **\$** Miss North Carolina Jr. High/High School/Collegiate Pageant—The pageant competition does not include a swimsuit or talent competition. There are numerous prizes and scholarship opportunities. To learn more visit www.missnorthcarolinahighschool.webs.com.
- **People Helping People Scholarship sponsored by the SECU Foundation**—Students must complete needed information & return to the Counseling Center by March 31, 2017. The Scholarship Committee may conduct interviews in order to make a decision for 1 Tuscola nomination.
- \$ Haywood Electric Membership Corporation—Students must have a minium 3.0 GPA, be a child, legal stepchild, or grandchild of an active Haywood EMC member. Must be accepted in an accredited university of community college and be enrolled in an Electrical Engineering or business affiliated major, such as Business Administration, Accounting, Marketing, Human Resources or Management. Applications must be submitted to the Counseling Center by April 3rd, 2017 so that we can attach transcripts and forward materials to Haywood EMC.
- S Crabtree-Ironduff Volunteer Fire Department Scholarship—Applications are available in the Counseling Center and complete application must be submitted by April 3, 2017. Eligible students must be a seniors residing in the Crabtree-Ironduff fire district, participate in extra-curricular activities and involvement in the community, have scholastic achievement, and demonstrated financial need. Please come by the Counseling Center for more information.
- \$ Alpha Delta Kappa Scholarships—Scholarship applications are available in the Counseling Center and are due back to the Counseling Center on March 1, 2017 so that we can turn in applications to local chapter by the deadline. There are 3 separate scholarships to apply for!
- Fines Creek Community Association Applicants must be a resident of the Fines Creek Community (Fines Creek, Panther Creek, White Oak, and Waterville). Criteria include being a resident of the Fines Creek Community for at least 2 years, must be a graduating senior with a minimum GPA of 2.5, must participate in FCCA fundraisers, accumulating to 10 hours, while being awarded the scholarship, and must of financial need. Applications are available in the counseling center. Deadline is May 1, 2017.
- **\$** The North Carolina Society of Accountants Scholarship—Students wishing to pursue a degree in Accounting. Applications are available in the Counseling Center and the deadline is April 15, 2017.

\$ The Golden LEAF Scholarship— Applications are available at CFNC.org/goldenleaf. The application deadline is March 1, 2017. Students must: • Be enrolled during the 2016-17 academic year at a North Carolina public or private high school or a North Carolina community college. • Be a North Carolina resident for tuition purposes. • Reside in one of 79 qualifying counties (see county list on the back, or at CFNC.org/goldenleaf). • Enroll at a qualifying UNC institution, or a North Carolina private non-profit college or university as a full-time, degree-seeking student in the Fall of 2017 (see listing of qualifying campuses on the back, or at CFNC.org/goldenleaf). • Demonstrate financial need. Students MUST submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to be considered for this scholarship.

• Present a satisfactory record of academic achievement and community service. Extracurricular activities and information provided in a brief essay submitted by the applicant may be considered in determining recipients. • Submit an application.

- \$ The Carrols LLC Community Scholarship Fund—Applications are available in the Counseling Center. Applications must be completed and returned by April 3, 2017. Winners are chosen on merit basis and completion of application, including attached transcripts and recommendations.
- \$ The Journey Scholarship—Applications are available in the Counseling Center and the scholarship is open to seniors who live in the Beaverdam, Bethel, Fine's Creek, North Hominy and Pigeon communities in Haywood County. Applications and needed materials must be postmarked by March 29, 2017.
