

NOVEMBER SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Please check with each college you are interested in regarding scholarships to ensure deadlines are met! This is not a complete list but scholarships that we are aware of at this time.

- **\$ NAVY ROTC Scholarships**—Please let your counselor know if you are interested in a Navy ROTC Scholarship so that we can set up a meeting with our local recruiter. The typical SAT score needed is 1150 for combined Critical Reading and Math or a ACT composite score of 24.
- Serea College Scholarships—Berea awards a 4-year, tuition scholarship to every admitted student. This scholarship works in conjunction with any other grants or scholarships students receive to completely cover the cost of tuition. If you are interested in attending Berea College please see your counselor!!!
- \$ Appalachian State University Scholarships— Complete your application for admission prior to the November 15 deadline with application for Admission, Official High School Transcript, Official Test Score(s): we accept both SAT and/or ACT, and Application Fee or Fee Waiver. Then Complete your Application for <u>Merit Scholarship and Selective Academic Programs</u> by November 15 with Two letters of recommendation, Resume, and Three individual essays (prompts are provided in the application). Watch your email and your <u>MyApp</u> account for more information. Select scholarship applicants will be invited to visit campus and interview for potential scholarship awards during Scholars Day.
- **\$** Robertson Scholars Leadership Program—The Scholarship Program provides scholarships to students attending Duke University & The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. The online application is available at www.robertsonscholars.org and the deadline to apply is November 15. Once registered, you can use your username and password to access your application at any time. Please remember, your application to the Robertson Scholars Leadership Program is supplemental to your application to Duke University or the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. You must also apply for admission to Duke and/or UNC-Chapel Hill by the respective Regular Decision deadline(s).
- **\$** University of Miami Scholarships—Students interested in scholarships need to apply for admission, along with an essay, CSS Profile and FAFSA—all due by December 1, 2016.
- Quest Whole Person Scholarship at Oral Roberts University—If students are interested in being nominated for this scholarship—they must let their counselor know by November 30, 2016.
- \$ Mensa Education and Research Foundation Scholarships—The only eligibility requirements are that the applicant be enrolled, for the academic year following the award, in a degree program in an accredited American institute of post-secondary education, and be a resident of the area of a participating local group of American Mensa. For the general awards, the applicant need not be a member of Mensa nor qualified for Mensa, and the general awards are unrestricted as to age, race, gender, level of post-secondary education and financial need. - \$ Ronald McDonald House Charities Scholarship Program—There are four different scholarships to apply for so please review information to see which scholarships you may be eligible for at https://aim.applyists.net/RMHC. We have had a Tuscola student win in the past so please apply! The application deadline is January 18, 2017.

- \$ Thomas Wolfe Scholarship at UNC Chapel Hill -The Thomas Wolfe Scholarship will accept applications for its 14th national search beginning September 1st, 2016. Please note that our application process involves two separate steps and two different dates, and all applicants must take both steps and meet both deadlines, to be eligible: 1) Thomas Wolfe Scholarship applicants must apply to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill by the University's October 15th, 2016. EARLY admission deadline and must meet all academic requirements for EARLY admission; and 2) Scholarship applicants must also apply to The Thomas Wolfe Scholarship, with the deadline for submissions to the Scholarship being November 15th, 2016 (submissions must be postmarked by that date). These are two distinct application processes and require different forms and separate mailings. The application is available at http://englishcomplit.unc.edu/creative/scholarship/tws.
- \$ Cooke Scholars Program—The Jack Kent Cooke Foundation College Scholarship Program is an undergraduate scholarship program available to high-achieving high school seniors with financial need who seek to attend and graduate from the nation's best four-year colleges and universities. Selected from a nationwide pool of applicants, up to 40 students will become Jack Kent Cooke Scholars and have access to funding for up to four years for undergraduate studies. Each award is intended to cover a significant share of the student's educational expenses – including tuition, living expenses, books and required fees. Awards vary by individual, based on the cost of tuition as well as other grants or scholarships he or she may receive. - \$ Clemson University Lyceum Scholars Program—Lyceum Scholars study the moral, political, and economics foundations of a free society. A unique curriculum and faculty mentor set this scholarship apart! Students need to apply at www.clemson.edu/capitalism/lyceum.html by December 1.
- \$ Ione M. Allen Music Scholarship—Applicants must demonstrate academic achievement and financial need, demonstrate traits of high personal character and leadership, demonstrate a musical aptitude, and must major in Music and be planning to attend a musical conservatory or other educational institution. Semi-Finalist will be interviewed by the Awards Advisory Committee, and will present a 5-minute musical performance. Deadline is January 2, 2017. Apply on-line at www.csascholars.org.
