## SEPTEMBER SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION



Please check with each college you are interested in regarding scholarships to ensure deadlines are met!

## Scholarship Meeting—Both Lunch Periods in Media Center Friday—September 8th, 2017

- \$ Morehead-Cain Scholarship at UNC-Chapel Hill—Applications are available in the Counseling Center. You must sign up & take an application to let us know you are interested. The applications are due in Counseling Center by Monday—September 18th at 3pm. The Scholarship Committee will then meet to decide THS's 3 school nominees. Those who are not chosen as the school's nominations can self-nominate online.
- **\$ Park Scholarship at NCSU**—Applications are available in the Counseling Center. You must sign up & take an application to let us know you are interested. The applications are due in Counseling Center by Monday—September 18th at 3pm. The Scholarship Committee will then meet to decide THS's 2 school nominees. Those who are not chosen as the school's nominations can self-nominate online.
- \$ Roan Scholarship—Applications are available in the Counseling Center. You must sign up & take an application to let us know you are interested. The applications are due in Counseling Center by Monday—September 18th at 3pm. The Scholarship Committee will then meet to decide THS's 2 school nominees. Those who are not chosen as the school's nominations can self-nominate online.
- \$ QuestBridge-National College Match—This is a service for High School Seniors who have Academic Achievement as well as Financial Need! A household income of lass than \$60,000 for a typical family of four, with limited assets may be considered. Scholarship assistance is part of the program to make certain colleges more affordable!
- **\$ NAVY ROTC Scholarships**—Please let your counselor know if you are interested in a Navy ROTC Scholarship so that we can set up a meeting with our local recruiter. The typical SAT score needed is 1150 for combined Critical Reading and Math or a ACT composite score of 24.
- Serea College Scholarships—Berea awards a 4-year, tuition scholarship to every admitted student. This scholarship works in conjunction with any other grants or scholarships students receive to completely cover the cost of tuition. If you are interested in attending Berea College—please see your counselor so we can nominate you for scholarships!!!
- \$ Wendy's High School Heisman—APPLY NOW!!! Student Athletes are encouraged to apply online at www.wendyshighschoolheisman.com/application/ by October 2nd!!! Please let Ms. Russell know when you have applied so that we can review your application online!

- **\$ DAR Good Citizens Scholarship**—This scholarship is based on a two part application.
  1) Students are asked how they have tried to manifest the qualities of a good citizen. This part is completed at home and is to be submitted together with a grade transcript and two letters of recommendation.
  2) Students are required to write a timed essay with prompt under the supervision of the School Counselor. Each entry is evaluated by independent, non DAR judges. The wining entry is advanced through state and national levels of judging. IF you would like to be considered for this scholarship, please let your school counselor know by October 1, 2017.
- **\$ Roanoke College Scholars Program**—To be considered for these scholarships, you must complete the Scholarship Competition application and be a prospective college freshman seeking first-time fall enrollment. You must also be accepted to the College prior to the competition. Students with at least a 3.2 cumulative grade point average in a rigorous academic curriculum should consider applying for the Scholarship Competition. For more information, students must visit www.roanoke.edu/scholars.
- \$ Davidson College Scholarships- If you are interested in attending Davidson College and you are interested in John Montgomery Belk Scholarship—please let your counselor know by October 15! There is a sign-up sheet in the Counseling Center and a nomination process for the school. The Belk Scholarship rewards students of demonstrated superior intellectual and person achievement and significant leadership ability. The Bryan Scholarship is for outstanding student athletes and nominations are required. Please let your counselor know if you are interested by September 18th!
- \$ Danforth Scholarship at Washington University in St. Louis—To be eligible for this scholarship, students must let their Counselor know! There is a sign-up sheet in the Counseling Center and students must be nominated by their counselor. We need to know of your interest by November 1st, 2017.
- \$ The Levine Scholars Program at University of North Carolina Charlotte—If students are interested in this scholarship—they must see their counselor by September 18, 2017. There is a sign-up sheet in the Counseling Center and a counselor must nominate students.
- **The Prudential Spirit of Community Awards**—If you've made a difference by volunteering in your community over the past year, you could win \$1,000 and a fabulous trip to Washington, D.C., by applying for a Prudential Spirit of Community Award! - \$ Goodnight Scholarship at NCSU—Students wishing to be considered for this scholarship must apply to NCSU by October 15th. More info is available at <a href="http://goodnight.ncsu.edu">http://goodnight.ncsu.edu</a> Students must be a North Carolina resident, have an adjusted gross income up to \$100,000 and demonstrate financial need, select a <a href="https://science">STEM (Science</a>, Technology, Engineering or Math) major or STEM education major, demonstrate a history of exceptional academic performance. The dynamic type of student selected to apply typically achieves the following: Rank in the top 2% of his/her graduating class, score above 1450 on the new SAT (CR+M) (equivalent to a 1400 on the old SAT) and/or score above a 32 on the ACT, and have at least a 3.9 (unweighted) GPA and/or 4.8 (weighted) GPA.
- \$ Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation—The online application is available at www.coca-colascholars.org and the deadline to complete is October 31, 2017. You will have to create a username & password to begin the application.
- **\$ Cheatham-White Scholarship at NCA&T** (North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University—Interested students should visit www.ncat.edu/academics/honors/cheatham-white for more information.

- \$ Appalachian State University Scholarships— Complete your application for admission prior to the November 15 deadline with application for Admission, Official High School Transcript, Official Test Score(s): we accept both SAT and/or ACT, and Application Fee or Fee Waiver. Then complete your application for Merit Scholarship and Selective Academic Programs by November 15 with two letters of recommendation, resume, and three individual essays (prompts are provided in the application). Watch your email and your MyApp account for more information. Select scholarship applicants will be invited to visit campus and interview for potential scholarship awards during Scholars Day. This invitation-only event is held each February.
- \$ Clemson University Lyceum Scholars Program—Lyceum Scholars study the moral, political, and economics foundations of a free society. A unique curriculum and faculty mentor set this scholarship apart! Students need to apply at www.clemson.edu/capitalism/lyceum.html.
- \$ Robertson Scholars Leadership Program—The Scholarship Program provides scholarships to students attending Duke University & The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. The online application is available at www.robertsonscholars.org and the deadline to apply is November 15. Once registered, you can use your username and password to access your application at any time. Please remember, your application to the Robertson Scholars Leadership Program is supplemental to your application to Duke University or the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. You must also apply for admission to Duke and/or UNC-Chapel Hill by the respective Regular Decision deadline(s).
- \$ Montreat College—WNC Scholarship Program at Montreat provides eligibile students in Haywood County an opportunity to apply. Students must have a 3.0 GPA and 1000 combined Critical Reading and Math score on SAT or 21 Composite ACT score. Apply for Admission by January 1, 2018. - **\$ National Co-Op Scholarship Program**—There is a book available in the Counseling Center to review if you are interested in these scholarships!
- **\$ TWS Jacksonville Scholarships** Several Welding Scholarships are available and more information is available in the Counseling Center.
- **\$** The Citadel Military College—Any minority student interested in The Citadel must see your counselor for more information regarding scholarship opportunities.

- **\$** The University of Alabama—Entering freshmen must submit the following by December 15 of their senior year in high school to be considered for academic scholarships: <u>Application for admission & Application for scholarships</u>, official high school transcript, official test score on either the ACT or SAT, required scholarship documentation (if applicable). The scholarship deadline is December 15 (the scholarship application should be submitted online by December 15 and any required materials sent by mail should be postmarked no later than December 15). This means that the national December ACT and national December SAT results are the last college entrance examination results accepted for students who wish to be considered for scholarships.

- **\$** The Shelton National Leadership Scholarship This is a four-year leadership scholarship/ stipend total package in the amount of \$40,000 tuition plus \$6,000 leadership enrichment stipend to support their college experience, if they choose to attend NC State University. The scholarship is awarded to an entering freshman, valued at \$10,000 per year, renewable upon satisfactory academic progress and leadership involvement at NC State. The scholarship is open to rising/current seniors who are in the process of applying for college in the fall semester of their senior year in high school. The application process is currently open and available for students to submit their application through October 15, 2017. More information is available at https://sheltonleadership.ncsu.edu.
- **\$ Thomas Wolfe Scholarship at UNC Chapel Hill** -The Thomas Wolfe Scholarship will accept

applications <u>beginning September 1st, 2017</u>. **Please note that our application process involves two separate steps and two different dates, and all applicants must take both steps and meet both deadlines, to be eligible:** 1) Thomas Wolfe Scholarship applicants must apply to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill by the University's October 15th, 2017. EARLY admission deadline and must meet all academic requirements for EARLY admission; and 2) Scholarship applicants must also apply to The Thomas Wolfe Scholarship, with the deadline for submissions to the Scholarship being November 15th, 2017 (submissions must be postmarked by that date). *These are two distinct application processes and require different forms and separate mailings.* The application is available at <u>http://englishcomplit.unc.edu/</u> <u>creative/scholarship/tws.</u>
