FEBRUARY SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION



Please check with each college you are interested in regarding scholarships to ensure deadlines are met! This is not a complete list but scholarships that we are aware of at this time.

- **\$** Alpha Delta Kappa Scholarships—Scholarship applications are available in the Counseling Center and are due back to the Counseling Center on March 1, 2018 so that we can turn in applications to local chapter by the deadline. There are 3 separate scholarships to apply for!
- **\$ Haywood County Schools Foundation Scholarships**—Applications are now available online at http://www.hcsf.haywood.k12.nc.us/ and typed applications are preferred. Students must apply for scholarships that they are eligible for so please check necessary requirements. Only the first page of the FAFSA form is needed, not the entire document. Students applying for HCSF, Champion Credit Union and the Reuben Robertson Scholarships, only need to fill out one application. They will just need to complete the separate essays as required. Students must submit completed applications to the Counseling Center no later than Monday—March 12, 2018.
- **\$** StudentScholarships.org—Search various scholarships such as:
 - Dr. Pepper Tuition Giveaway Scholarship, VIP Voice Scholarships, Student Photography Scholarship, National Space Club Scholarship AND more.....
- **\$ 2018-2019 Golden Leaf Scholarship**—There are several requirements for the scholarship and the application is available at CFNC.org/goldenleaf. The application deadline is March 1, 2018.
- **B. Davis Scholarship**—The creators of the "Student Award Search Aid website are offering a scholarship. Please visit our website at http://www.studentawardsearch.com/scholarships.htm to read about us and apply for the scholarship. While you are there, browse through other scholarships. This site is free and application deadline is **May 22, 2018**.
- **People Helping People Scholarship sponsored by the SECU Foundation**—Students can find application and information located on the Haywood County Schools Foundation Scholarship website. Applications must be submitted to the Counseling Center no later than Monday—**March 12, 2018**. The Scholarship Committee may conduct interviews in order to make a decision for 1 Tuscola nomination.
- **The Journey Scholarship**—Applications are available in the Counseling Center and the scholarship is open to seniors who live in the Beaverdam, Bethel, Fine's Creek, North Hominy and Pigeon communities in Haywood County. Applications and needed materials must be postmarked by **March 23, 2018**.
- **Alpha lota Scholarship**—Applications are available in the Counseling Center and are due in the mail to the committee chair, Alissa Cheek, by **March 30, 2018**.
- **Pop & Marj Kelly Merit Scholarship**—Applicants must be planning to attend HCC and have a 3.5 or better GPA. There will be 5 \$10,000 schoalrships available!!! Applications are available in the Counseling Center and must be submitted to Tom Jones, Scholarship Specialist at HCC by Friday—April 6, 2018.
- \$ 2018 Walker Morgan Scholarship—Applicants must currently be a high school senior, have a 2.5 GPA or higher, and either the applicant or a direct family member must have been personally affected by an injury of some type.
