

Physical Science or Chemistry, Earth & Environmental Science, & Biology


#### Social Studies (4 credits)

# **Elective Credits**

# Electives or Other Requirements (6 credits) 2 Elective credits of any combination from either:

- Career & Technical Ed.(CTE)
- Arts Education
- World Language (2 years required to meet minimum admission requirement for public colleges in NC)

# 4 Elective credits (four course concentration) from one of the following:

- Career & Technical Education (CTE)
- JROTC
- Arts Education
- Any other subject area (Math, Science, English, World Language, etc.)

### Credits required for Promotion

- 9<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> grade: 6 credits with 1 being English and another core credit.
- 10<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> grade: 12 credits with 2 credits being in English.
- 11<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade: 20 credits with 2
   being in English and it must be possible for all other graduation requirements to be met during the upcoming year.

### Typical 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Course Selections

Ould be standard or honors level

#### Ourses:

- English
- Math
- World History
- Physical Science or Earth & Environmental
- Health and PE
- 3 Electives

### 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Honors Courses

- Must meet prerequisite
- Courses available to 9<sup>th</sup> graders:
  - English 1 Honors
  - English 2 Honors (must have taken Eng. 1 in 8<sup>th</sup> grade)
  - Earth and Environmental Science Honors
  - Math 2 Honors (must have taken Math 1 in 8<sup>th</sup> grade)
  - World History Honors

### Math Placement

- All students will select a math
  - Students currently taking Math 1 will select Math 2 or Math 2 Honors
  - Students currently taking 8<sup>th</sup> grade math will select "Math"
    - For these students, math placement will be made according to proficiency and growth data

#### PROGRESSIVE MATH

- Students will have opportunity to work through Math 1 in same semester
- If students do not show growth and proficiency can receive a Foundations credit.

### **Progressive Math**

- O Module-based / Multiple teachers
- At 6 weeks mark benchmark assessments will determine if students are progressing to Module 2
  - Students will be assigned to teacher based on successful mastery within the Module
- At 9<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> week 2<sup>nd</sup> benchmark assessment will determine which students have progressed to Math 1

#### **Course Request Process:**

- **Step 1**: Pick up Course Request Sheet after tonight's meeting in the cafeteria
- Step 2: Review course of studies book and plan requests using Roadmap as a guide
- Step 3: Complete and return the Course Request
   Sheet to homeroom teacher by morning of April 6<sup>th</sup>
  - Select top <u>7</u> choices by placing an X beside the course
  - Select <u>4</u> alternates by placing an A beside the course (<u>must</u> be courses willing to take)

- **Step 4**: Requests, as indicated on the registration form, will be entered into PowerScheduler
- Step 5: Prerequisites will be checked to see if students meet
  - If grade prerequisite is met, student will be qualified and request will remain in PowerScheduler
  - if not teachers will be asked to provide a recommendation and corrections will be made as needed.
- Step 6: THS will begin creating the master schedule

<u>NOTE</u>: Students taking honors classes will receive notification if summer assignments are applicable.

# Schedule Changes

Because the administration must plan for the next school year based on the subjects selected now, students cannot change selections after registration is complete unless one of the following criterion is met:

- Incorrect Placement
- Meeting Graduation Requirements (Seniors only)
- O Balancing classes
  - 2 Core/2 Electives per semester
